I am writing to announce that Kim Siniscalchi, DNP, R.N., FAAN, Vice President for Strategic Initiatives, will be leaving UT Southwestern this month to assume a new academic position at UT Arlington. Kim completed her Doctor of Nursing Practice degree at Duke University in December and will serve as a Professor and Strategic Advisor to the Dean for UT Arlington's College of Nursing and Health Innovation.
