Her main issue is getting up by herself in the middle of the night to go to the bathroom. She would not remember to ask for help and twice we had close calls where she almost fell; luckily the fall alarm she was wearing alerted you that she had gotten out of bed. You are worried that she will fall at home without such care. She also had an early stage pressure area on her sacrum that your staff were able to notice and take care of with good nursing care and turning her every 2 hours when she came from the hospital. Now that she is walking and able to get up more, this area is better.
