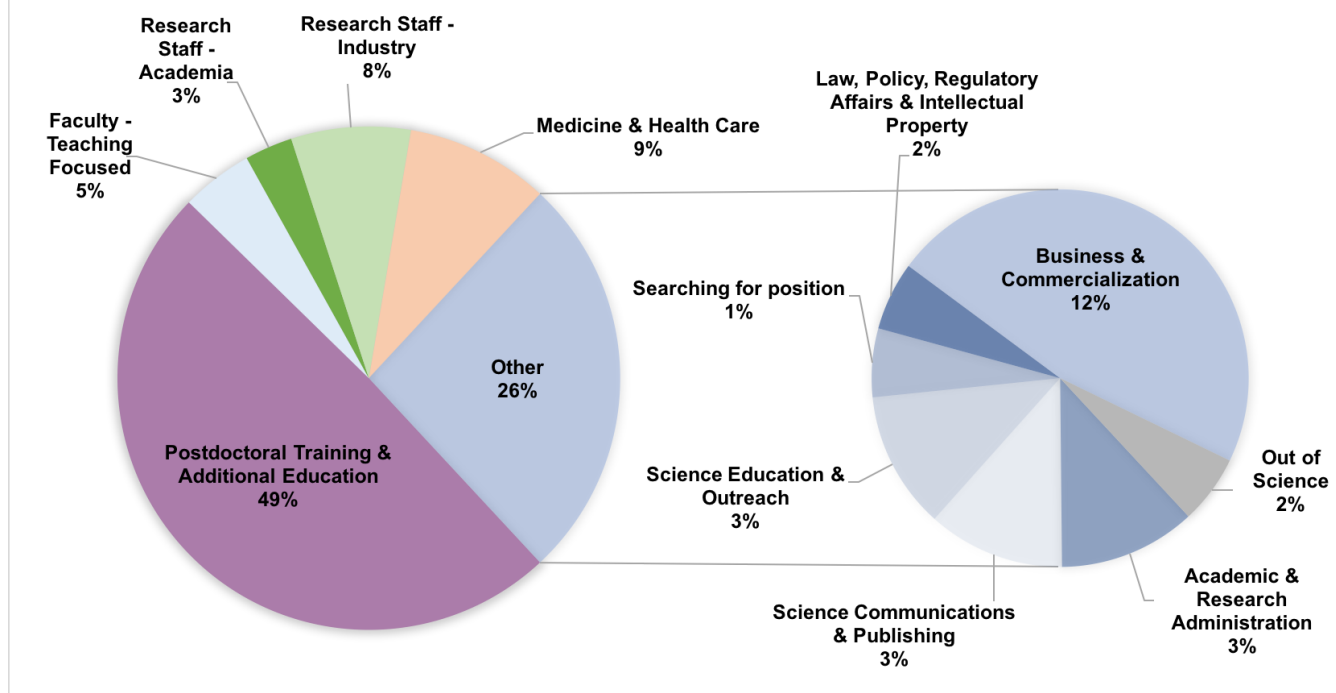


**CANCER BIOLOGY
PROFESSIONAL OUTCOMES OF GRADUATES
2009 TO 2016**



65 students who earned a PhD or MD/PhD since 2009¹

- **Postdoctoral Fellowships** – 32 graduates are currently either doing a postdoctoral fellowship or pursuing additional education:
 - Institutions include: Harvard, Cold Spring Harbor Laboratory, Salk Institute, Scripps Research Institute, Dana-Farber Cancer Institute, several University of California institutions, St. Jude Children’s Research Hospital, Weill Cornell Medical Center, Washington University, Memorial Sloan-Kettering Medical Center.
 - One graduate is a medical student at University of North Texas Health Science Center.
- **Research Staff** – 7 are researchers in either industry or academia.
 - Sample corporations: Eli Lilly, BerGenBio, Novartis, Wisser Together, Inc.
 - Academic research staff are working at UT Dallas and UT Southwestern.
- **Business & Commercialization** – includes 8 graduates who are analysts with companies such as Green, Park & Golf Ventures (biotech venture capital), Clearview Healthcare Partners and Numerof & Associates (both life sciences consulting firms), application specialists with Bristol-Myers Squibb, LI-COR Biosciences, and Ally Clinical Diagnostics, as well as an entrepreneur who started his own company.
- **Faculty Positions** – 3 graduates are teaching at Dallas Baptist University, San Diego Community College, and St. Mary’s University.
- **Medicine & Healthcare** – 5 of the 6 MD/PhD degree-holders are completing residencies or clinical fellowships; the remaining MSTP graduate is a research professor at UT Dallas.
- **Remaining graduates** – 2 are in research administration in industry; and 2 are medical writers. The remaining graduates are a technology analyst, the director of the STEM Center at El Centro College and a community educator for a health care organization. 1 is searching for a position and another is out of science.
