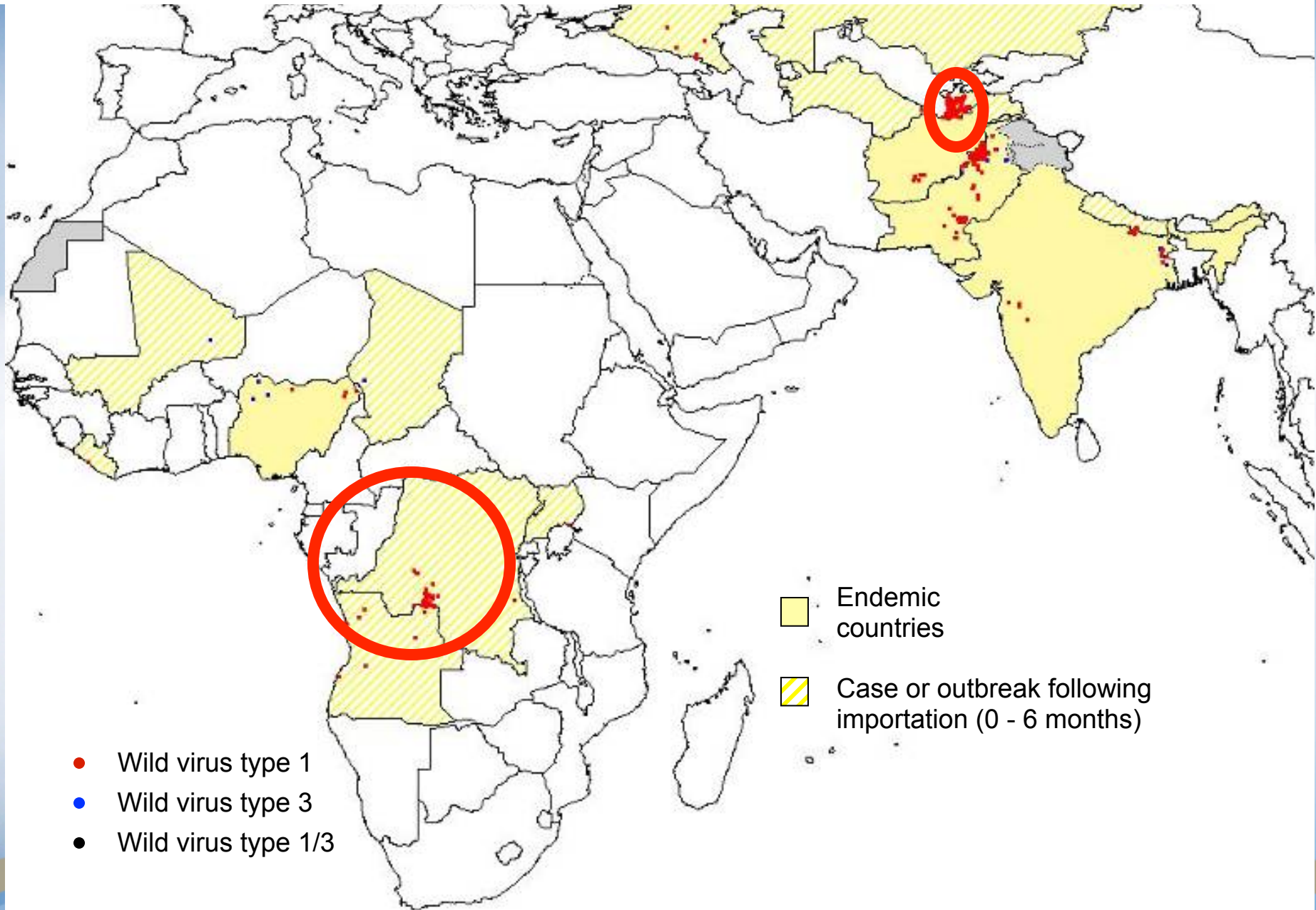

What are Packaged Global Grants?

- Opportunities for Rotary clubs in pilot districts
- Pre-designed projects funded by the World Fund and the strategic partner, no DDF required
- Can include scholarships, humanitarian projects, and vocational training
- Rotarians can focus their talents and energies on implementation
