Externships for Visiting Medical Students

Maternal–Fetal Medicine Sub–Internship

Visiting medical students will function as interns on a team in the <u>Division of Maternal–</u> <u>Fetal Medicine</u>. They will be assigned 6–8 patients in the High-Risk Pregnancy Unit at <u>Parkland Memorial Hospital</u>.

Externs will make rounds daily and will be responsible for the care of assigned patients, including delivery. Students will have the opportunity to share their knowledge with the on-service attending during daily ward rounds. They will see patients in the OB Complications Clinic three to four afternoons a week and attend conferences with their team.
