

Molecular Diagnostics Rotation - Objectives

Practice-Based Learning and Improvement

A. Objectives:

1. What constitutes practice-based learning and improvement (e.g. the application of the medical literature, research and statistical methods, and data management technology for self-evaluation and improvement) on this rotation? The ability to interpret and sign out results constitutes practice-based learning.

B. Plan:
