

Forensic Pathology Rotation - Objectives

Professionalism

A. **Objectives:**

- i. Ability to complete autopsy reports in 30 days (75%) and 60 days (100%)
- ii. Ability to independently prepare an autopsy report, including gross and microscopic descriptions, findings and a concise conclusion which is free (or nearly free) of significant errors
- iii. Ability to show respect for the body during the autopsy

B. **Plan:**

- i. The resident will prepare autopsy reports to be presented to the attending pathologist.

C. **Supervision/Assessment:**

- i. Objectively, by review of turn-around time of the autopsy report by the resident, tabulated and determined by the Autopsy Director, or a duly appointed designee
- ii. Subjectively by the attending pathologist during editing/correction of the autopsy report
- iii. Informally, during interactions with the resident during the month by the attending pathologists
