# Updates to IRB Withdrawal Procedures

- For New Studies that are Clinical Trials – we will return the study to Draft state instead of withdrawing the submission
  - This will allow work on the submission and resubmission when all issues have been resolved
  - To avoid any work that has been done in Velos on the record associated with the IRB protocol number
- Non-Clinical trials will continue to be withdrawn if response not received by deadline provided by the analyst. You will be required complete and submit a new study.
