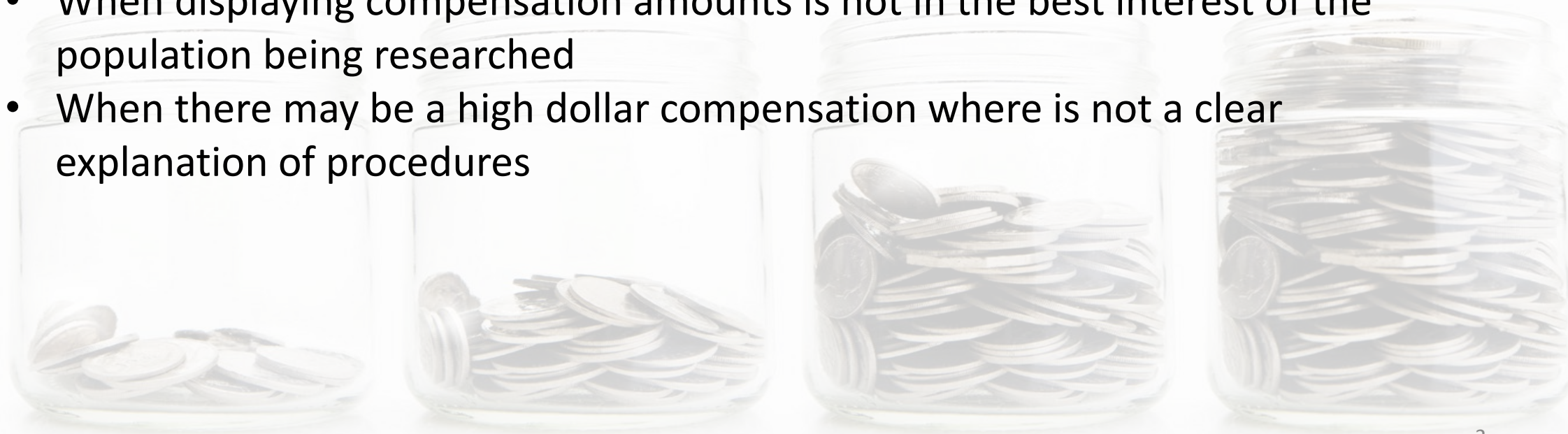

Recruitment Materials and Compensation

- Compensation **may** be included on recruitment materials; however, the IRB may determine that the amount should not be disclosed on the advertisement.
- IRB Considerations on when it may not be best to include the amount on the recruitment materials include:
 - When compensation is different in each group a protocol
 - When displaying compensation amounts is not in the best interest of the population being researched
 - When there may be a high dollar compensation where is not a clear explanation of procedures

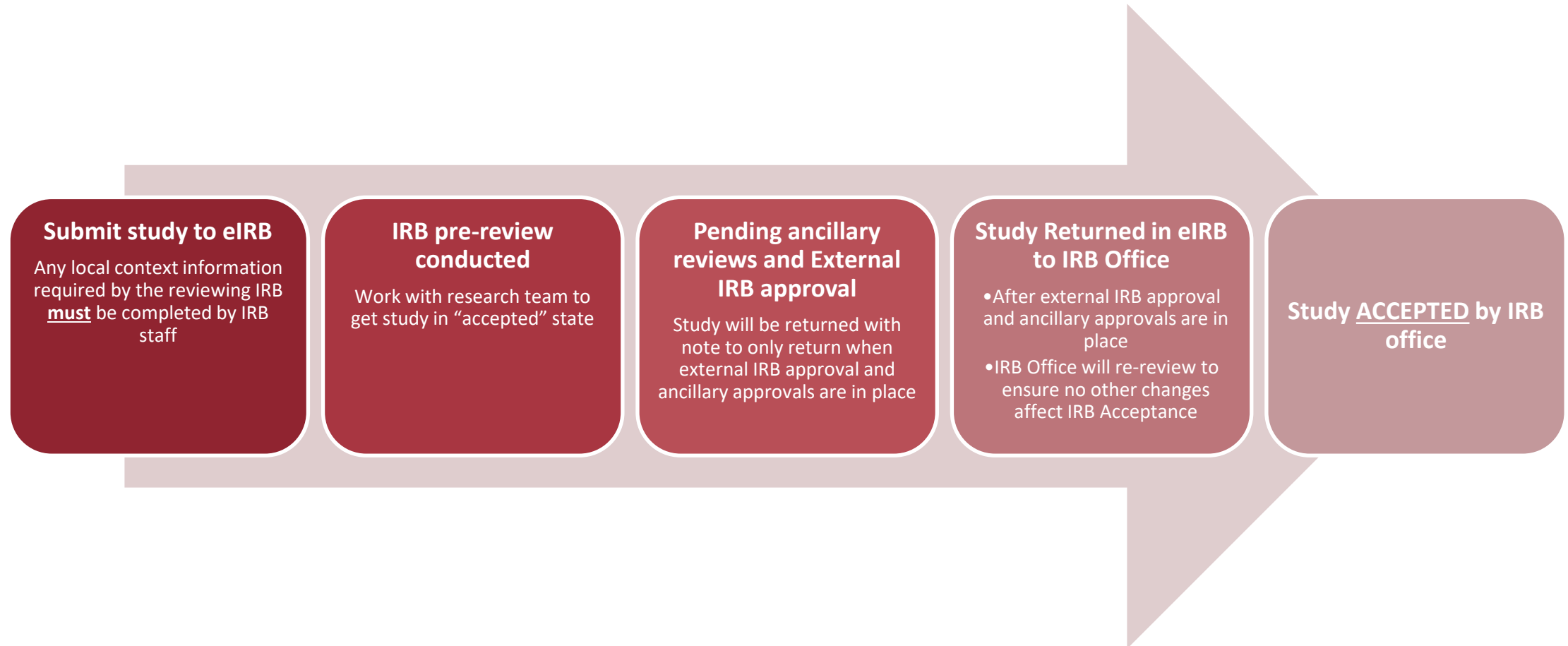


Reliance studies can be submitted before external IRB approval

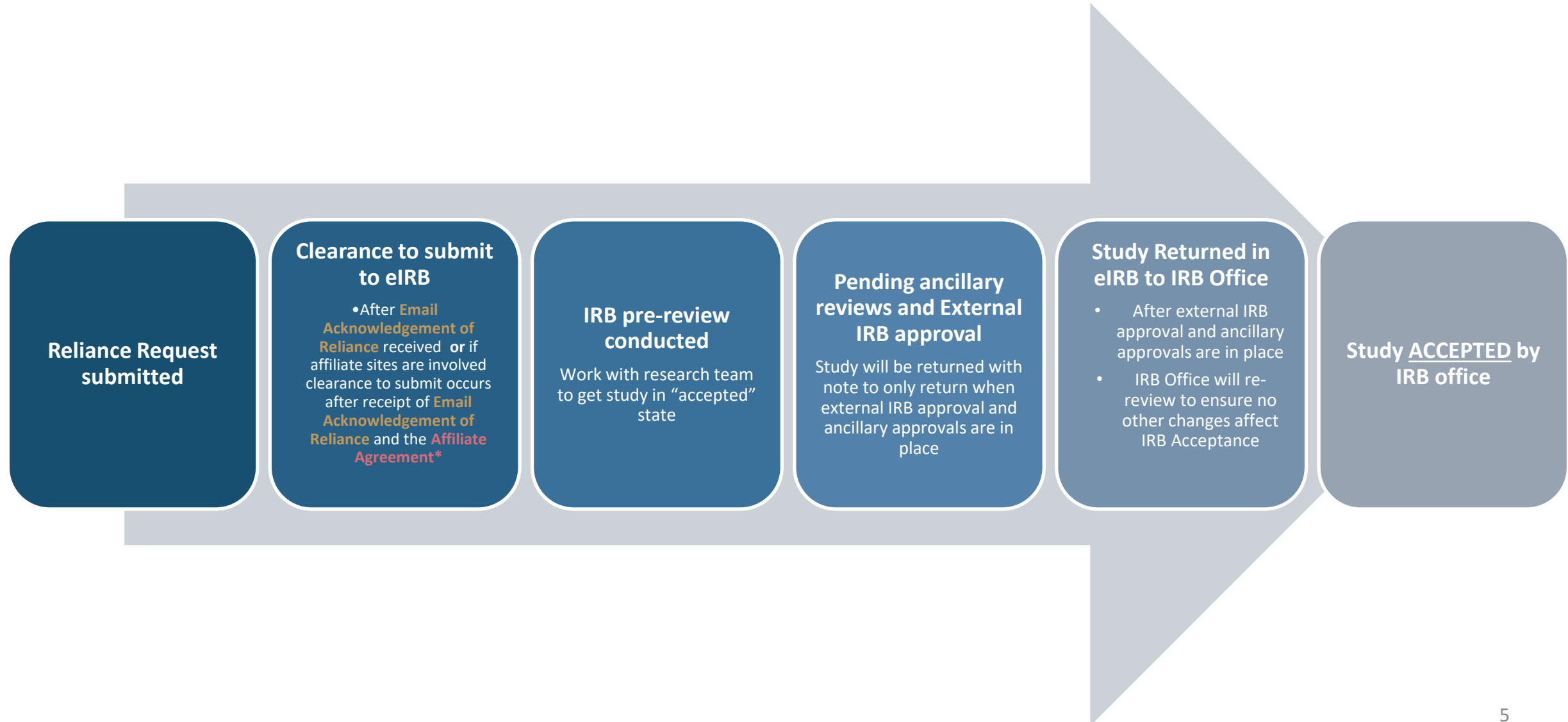


- Allows for early on some ancillary reviews
- Early performance site access

Reliance on all Other External IRBs

Reliance Request submitted

Clearance to submit to eIRB

- After **Email Agree to Cede to External IRB** received by research team
- Important to ensure UTSW IRB has received entire **Reliance package from External IRB**
- *Reliance Package = Reliance agreement & Local context form (aka, protocol specific document) from reviewing IRB*

IRB pre-review conducted

Work with research team to get study in “accepted” state

Pending ancillary reviews and External IRB approval

Study will be returned with note to only return when external IRB approval and ancillary approvals are in place

Study Returned in eIRB to IRB Office

- After external IRB approval and ancillary approvals are in place
- IRB Office will re-review to ensure no other changes affect IRB Acceptance
