Goal of This Course:

The primary goal of this training is to provide trainees with the skills to select effective behavioral interventions(s) that fit their communities' HIV prevention needs and organizations' capacities'. In addition, this course provides the foundation for successful adaptation and implementation of the intervention(s).

Training Objectives:

By the end of this training, participants will be able to:

- *List four steps in selecting an effective behavioral intervention (EBI);*
- *Describe how behavioral interventions work to change behaviors;*
- *Use community assessment results to identify HIV risk behaviors and risk factors of a target population and to narrow that population to an intervention;*
- *Examine EBI –specific behavioral change logic models to assess behavioral interventions;*
- *Assess agency capacity in relation to EBIs implementation plans;*
- *Match the results of a community assessment, intervention examination, and agency capacity to select an appropriate EBI; and*
- *Identify available technical assistance recourses*
