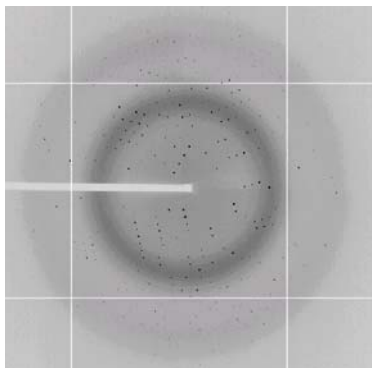

2009 FRANK AND SARA MCKNIGHT PRIZE IN UNDERGRADUATE BIOPHYSICS OR COMPUTATIONAL BIOLOGY

Senior undergraduates are invited to compete for one of three prizes (1st: **\$2000**; 2nd: **\$1000**; 3rd: **\$500**) recognizing outstanding undergraduate research achievement in the fields of **biophysics or computational biology**. Interested students should submit: (1) An abstract describing their research, (2) GRE scores (if available), (3) GPA, (4) a letter of support from their research mentor and (5) a mailing address *no later than October 1, 2009*.

Finalists will be invited to present posters of their research at the UT Southwestern Biochemistry Research Retreat, held November 6-8, 2009. Winners will be chosen on their undergraduate achievement and significant of their research. Travel and accommodations for finalists will be provided by UT Southwestern.
