### Purpose and Content:

An intensive three-day training of facilitators provides skills and information that is need for participants to facilitate the intervention. This TOF will not provide basic group facilitation skills. Each agency is responsible for ensuring that their staff who will be delivering Many Men, Many Voices be adequately trained in group facilitation skills.

### Objectives:

- Ability to facilitate all components of a realistic, workable client-centered intervention.
- Provide intervention curriculum and client hand-outs.
- Opportunity to practice delivering the intervention.
- Discuss pre implement, agency capacity issues, intervention maintenance and management.
- Review tools and skills for recruitment, retention, evaluation, and incentives.
