



## Welch Foundation/UT SOUTHWESTERN Graduate Fellowships in Chemistry

THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS SOUTHWESTERN MEDICAL CENTER is currently accepting applications for Welch Foundation/UT Southwestern Graduate Fellowships in Chemistry. As part of this program, graduate students will conduct research at the interface between synthetic organic chemistry and biomedical research. Fellows can join research groups with interests ranging from organometallic chemistry to natural products synthesis, and pursue collaborative projects with biochemists, biophysicists, and molecular biologists. Graduate coursework available includes physical organic and synthetic chemistry, as well as advanced topics in spectroscopy, reaction mechanisms, and catalysis. Students with excellent academic records and experience in chemical research are encouraged to apply. The fellowship will pay tuition, medical benefits, and include a \$32,000 annual stipend.
