The North and Central Texas Clinical and Translational Science Initiative (NCTCTSI) Pilot Grant Award Program is intended to provide support for innovative clinical and translational research projects from investigators participating in the NCTCTSI. This program is funded in part by the NIH UL1 RR014982. The primary purpose of the program is to assist the investigator in acquiring preliminary data for extramural grant submission. Proposals will undergo rigorous peer-review conducted by a committee of experienced researchers from all NCTCTSI participating institutions. The program will track the success of the pilot award recipients to facilitate extramural funding.
