

Biomedical Engineering Postdoctoral Position

A postdoctoral position in the field of biomedical engineering is available in the Department of Radiation Oncology at UT Southwestern Medical Center (Dallas campus).

Candidates must hold a Ph.D.; preference will be given to candidates who hold a Ph.D. specializing in therapeutic device development and possess qualifications in cancer biology. The position is slated to commence in January 2024.

Key responsibilities associated with this role:

- Enhance the utilization of therapeutic devices for both in vitro and in vivo applications related to cancer therapy.
- Expertise in crafting grant proposals and preparing manuscripts for publication.
- Provide guidance and oversight to both graduate and undergraduate students working within the laboratory.
- Annual renewal of the position will hinge on job performance evaluations and the continued availability of adequate support.
