To the UT Southwestern Community:

With the forthcoming retirement of **Holly Crawford, M.B.A.**, at the end of this month and as we continue our search for the next Executive Vice President for Business Affairs, I am pleased to announce that **Marc Nivet, Ed.D., M.B.A.**, has agreed to serve in this role on an interim basis, effective June 1.

Since Ms. Crawford announced her retirement plans last fall, we have undertaken a thoughtful, national search to find the next permanent leader for this critically important role. We remain committed to selecting an exceptional candidate whose experience and vision will further strengthen the operational and financial foundation supporting our education, research, and patient care priorities.

In the meantime, I am grateful that Dr. Nivet will provide interim leadership for Business Affairs while continuing his responsibilities as Executive Vice President for Institutional Advancement. Since joining UT Southwestern in 2016, Dr. Nivet has been a valued member of our senior leadership team and has contributed significantly to strategic initiatives across our community. His broad experience – including past service as the Chief Operating Officer and Treasurer for the Josiah Macy Jr. Foundation and executive leadership at the Association of American Medical Colleges – and ability to build alignment across complex organizations position him well to oversee the many administrative, financial, operational, and service functions within Business Affairs. He also served as Interim Vice President for Human Resources in 2021, during a period that led to the recruitment of Jeremy Falke, M.B.A. Dr. Nivet's collaborative leadership, strategic insight, and deep institutional knowledge will help ensure continuity and sustained momentum during this transition.

I also want to express my appreciation to the outstanding leaders and teams across Business Affairs whose dedication and expertise continue to strengthen our institution every day.

Please join me in thanking Ms. Crawford again for her many contributions to UT Southwestern and in supporting Dr. Nivet as he takes on this additional leadership responsibility.
