Shop the Summer Bash sale

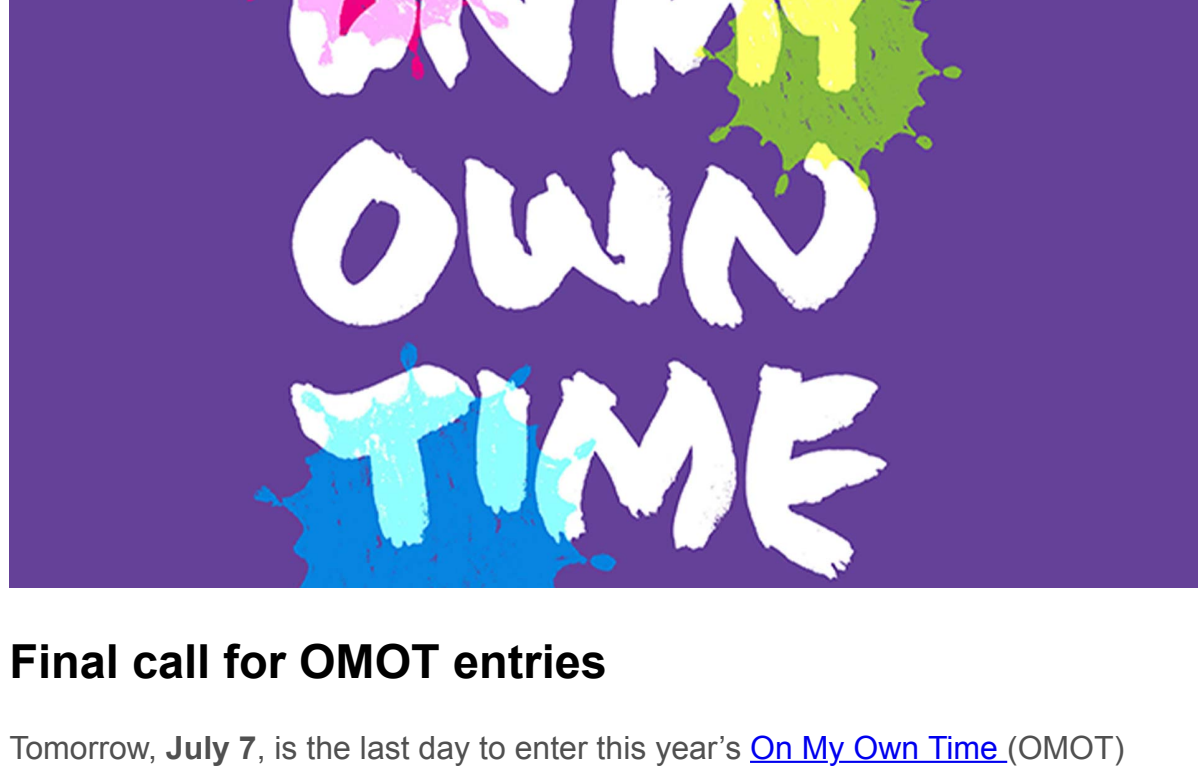

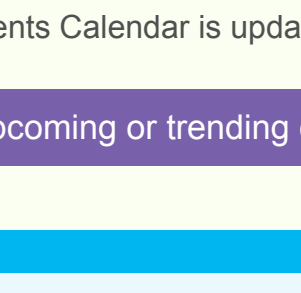
MS Word to Adobe PDF: How to Create Accessible, Simple Forms
