Generic Didactic Schedule

Tuesday conferences start at 09:00 for fellows and at 10:00 for rotators unless otherwise noted.

09:00-10:00	Fellows Only	Fellows Only Session Higher-level fellow and attending discussion emphasizing board review, literature review, communication, professionalism, and other non-knowledge core competencies.
10:00-11:00	Morning Report	Morning Report Case-based review and discussion led by the service team or assigned faculty.
11:00-12:00	Toxic News and Reviews	Toxic News and Reviews Review of current toxicology-related events, literature, and public health issues with attention to patient care and systems implications.
12:00-13:00	Webinars	AACT Section Webinar / Working Lunch National webinar or working lunch block aligned with external AACT programming when available.
13:00-14:00	Grand Rounds	Toxicology Grand Rounds Special presentation on a toxicology-related topic for fellows, faculty, Poison Center staff, emergency medicine personnel, and other invited participants.

10:30-11:30	Morning Report	Dr. Paul Wax Discussion Faculty-led discussion block for applied case review, clinical reasoning, and advanced toxicology teaching.

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12:30-14:00	Occupational Core Content	Occupational Tox and Risk Assessment Applied occupational toxicology and risk assessment discussion using assigned topics and faculty-directed review.

10:00-11:00	Occupational Core Content	Occupational Core Content Review Wednesday textbook chapter review of occupational content for the week whose Tuesday conference (Occupational Tox and Risk Assessment) is a lecture rather than a textbook review. Alternates with the core review.

12:30-14:00	General Core Content	General Core Content Review Wednesday textbook chapter review of core content on fifth-Wednesday weeks, extending the core rotation in months that have a fifth Tuesday. Alternates with the occupational review.
