UT Southwestern has developed an information sheet to educate patients about the basics of clinical trial participation and about the Stablemates trial in particular.

The information sheet will be made available in pdf form in both English and Spanish versions for sites to print out and distribute as needed. We are currently waiting for IRB approval before releasing.

Feedback from our subsites has suggested that some patients can be overwhelmed by the amount of information presented to them at consultation, and

would benefit from having a "take home" sheet to review. This sheet can be used in combination with our patient education video (located here and on the home page of the Stablemates web site) to help patients understand their treatment options as well as the prerandomization process.

We encourage you to identify and share any barriers to patient enrollment you may have encountered so far. If we know about particular barriers patients are facing, we may be able to devise solutions when appropriate.


