

Quick tips

Clarification on eligibility. Please check "Yes" on the online eligibility form in REDCap if the prospective trial participant has "no prior invasive malignancy, unless disease-free for ≥ 3 years prior to registration (exceptions: non-melanoma skin cancer, in-situ cancers)". Some sites have been checking "No" to indicate their patients have no prior malignancies, without observing the pagative phrasing of the question. Please check "Yes"

Getting paid. If we have requested a W-8 or W-9 form from your site, please expedite sending it in so that we can pay you.

Patient plans. As a reminder, please submit plans on an ongoing basis for all patients. A rapid review will be conducted prior to treatment of the first patient, while all others may be submitted after treatment.
