PeriPAN Support

Rapid access to mental health support from a multidisciplinary reproductive psychiatry team.

Why PeriPAN?

- » Maternal mental health conditions are the most common complications of pregnancy and childbirth
 - In Texas, maternal mental health conditions affect more than 1 in 8 pregnant and postpartum women
 - Nearly 50k Texan mothers who gave birth in 2019 had a mental health concern like depression
- » Every Texas county has a shortage of mental health care professionals
- » PeriPAN connects front-line maternal health providers to reproductive psychiatrists to help address maternal mental health concerns
- » Enrolling is quick and easy

How does PeriPAN work?

- » PeriPAN's goal is to increase your capacity to treat maternal mental health conditions in real-time
- » When you have a mental health question about a patient, call 1-888-901-2726
- » You will speak directly with a mental health clinician to assess and address your question
- » A mental health clinician can assist you with resources and any necessary referrals for your patient
- » If you have a diagnostic or medication question, a reproductive psychiatrist will return your call as quickly as possible or you can schedule a call back at your preferred time
- » PeriPAN is currently funded in four regions across Texas. Work is ongoing to expand PeriPAN statewide
