Main Program Objectives:

- To identify and obtain support and guidance on clinical, research, personal, and administrative thoughts and ideas for residents
- To ensure each resident has at least one mentor by the end of residency

- Plan next meeting



Meeting 3: Jan – March

- Review Block 2 experiences: strengths, weaknesses, takeaways
- Provide update on Block 3 selectives / electives
- Discuss scheduling PGY4
- Discuss updates (research, QI projects, presentations, leadership roles, etc.)
- Plan next meeting



Meeting 4: April – July

- Provide update on Block 3 selectives / electives; review takeaways from year
- Address fellowship applications/interviews -OR-
- Discuss early networking/ job search, applications (CV, statement, professional photo, etc.)
- Plan next meeting
