## Intravenous Pyelography (IVP) Preparation

#### What is an IVP?

An IVP is an X-ray test that lets the doctor check your kidney, ureter and bladder.

#### How will my test be done?

An IV line will be started in your arm and x-ray dye will be injected via the vein. It is normal to feel warm or flushed all over during the dye injection. You may have a taste like metal in your mouth. Then a series of x-rays will be taken to examine the kidneys, ureters and urinary bladder.

The test will take about 1 hour.

### Preparing for your IVP

- Please follow the instructions carefully since having a clean bowel is essential for a good exam. On the day before your exam, please drink plenty of clear liquids to avoid dehydration. *If you are on a fluid restricted diet or diabetic, please discuss with your doctor first. Failure to follow these instructions may result in the cancellation of your procedure.*
- Take all of your medications as prescribed. If you are on insulin your dosage may need to be adjusted the day prior and morning of the test, contact your physician for dosage instructions.
- If you are allergic to IV dye, you may need to be pre-medicated starting the day before your examination period. If you have not already notified us please call (214) 645-9729.
