		The Aim Statement can be measured
		The measure is readily understandable by the team
		There is a direct relation between the increase and the decrease of the measure and the attainment or loss of the Aim Statement.
		If needed, a procedure can be put in place that can consistently take, collect and report the measure
		If the measure needs to be sampled, a representative sampling of the total (day of week, time of day, type of patient, etcetera) can be taken
		ACTIONABLE
		The Aim Statement requires a deliberate action toward making an improvement (not just to study, evaluate, etcetera)
		The members have or can gain the competency/capability needed to make probable solutions a reality
		Members have a willingness to create a solution for this Aim Statement
		REALISTIC
		The attainment of the Aim Statement is within the control or at least the influence of the members
		The members have both the time and the resources to achieve this Aim Statement.
		The Aim Statement achievement is not limited by regulatory, legal, ethical or other requirements
		Leadership supports the team time for staff to diagnose, generate solutions, implement changes and sustain the measurement collection.
		The anticipated resources to achieve this Aim Statement will be worth the value to obtain/implement them
		The content knowledge needed to achieve the Aim Statement is with in the staff's capability, or available from outside the clinic
		There is a good chance the team will be successful in achieving this Aim Statement.
		TIMELY
		There is a target date specified for achieving this Aim Statement
		Conditions in the environment are ripe for implementing this Aim Statement
		There is a sense of urgency, shared need or benefit for achieving the Aim Statement at this time
		Staff availability is good at this time to evaluate, create and implement the Aim Statement
		There are no significant initiatives that might compete for staff time and attention working toward the Aim Statement at this time.
