## Tip Sheet to Return to the Clinical Research Foundations Course on CITI

The following instructions are for logging in to return to your Clinical Research Foundations (CRF) course on the CITI website: (<a href="https://about.citiprogram.org/">https://about.citiprogram.org/</a>). If you need to access any specific modules within the CRF course, please note that you will only be able to review them *after* you've completed them **in their sequence of appearance**.

1. Once you login, you will be taken to your Welcome page. Scroll down to this section of the page and click on View Courses:




- If you have enrolled in the course but have not started it yet, you will locate the CRF course under Courses Ready to Begin
- If you have already enrolled to the CRF course but are still working on it, then you will find it under Active Courses
- 4. If you have already completed the CRF course, you will now find it under Completed Courses



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Remember: to access all the modules within the CRF course, you will need to complete them in their order of appearance. You **cannot** skip ahead to a later module in the listing if you have not completed the previous module. For instance, in this example you would **not** be able to access **Scientific Principles of Clinical Research** until **Leadership Welcome and Major Departments** was marked as "**Complete**" in the system:



Once you complete a CRF CITI module, you can click "Review" on any of the modules you wish to access **and** have completed:
