
What we do: Sponsored Programs Administration at UT Southwestern supports and assists faculty with applying for funding, fiscal management of grants and contracts received from funding sources (i.e., federal, non-federal, state and private sponsors) and research financial compliance.

How we do it: Most academic research institutions, like UT Southwestern, use a *lifecycle approach* to manage research administration, from proposal submission through award closeout. Our lifecycle approach applies to basic science, clinical research, and translational research endeavors.


