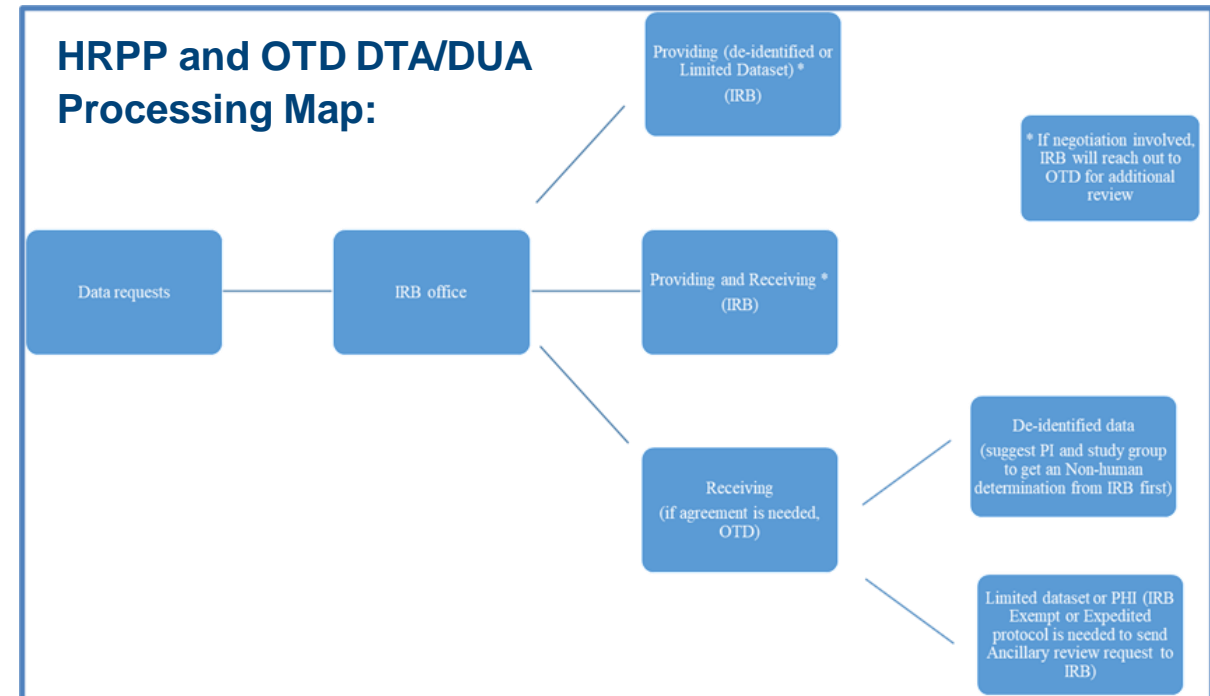

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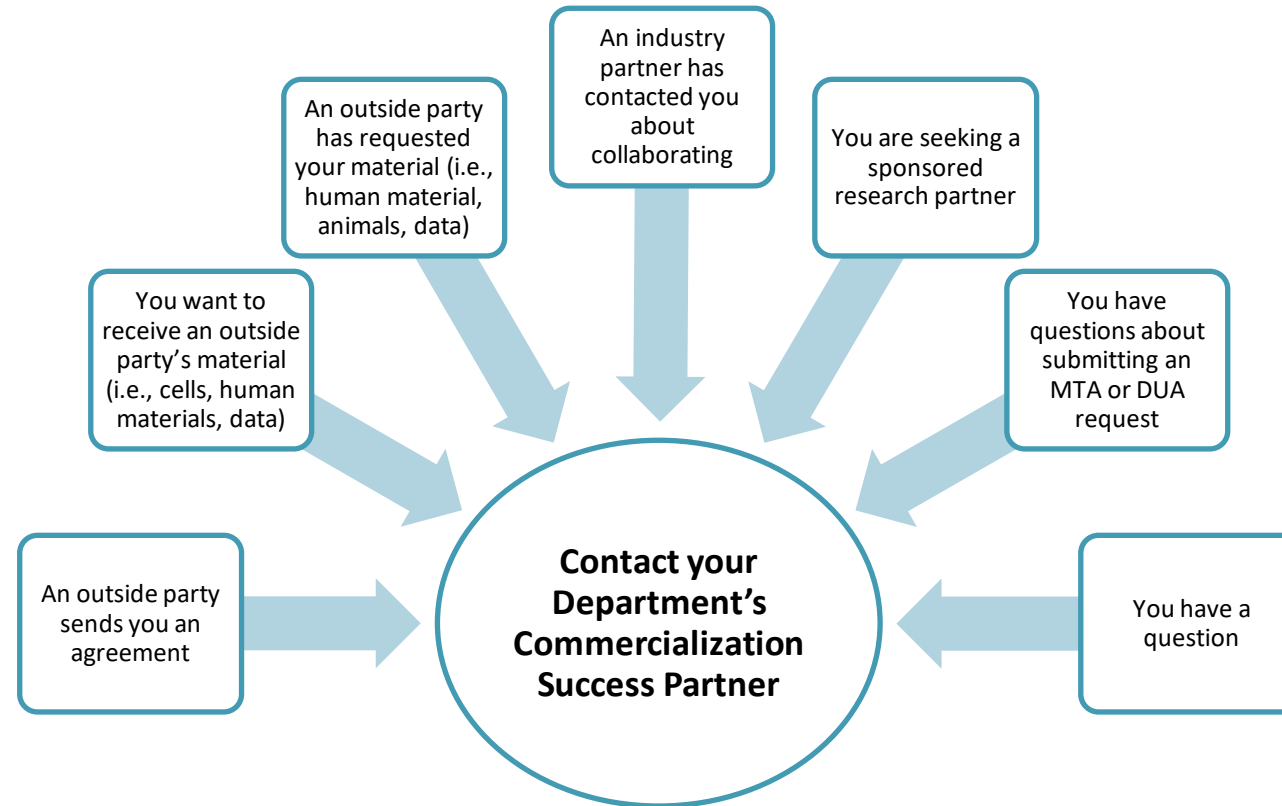
Office for Technology
Development (OTD)

The Agreements below are the responsibility of OTD. All require IRB approval:

- **Receiving Data Transfer Agreement (DTA).** A DTA outlines the rights and obligations pertaining to the use, handling, protection and safeguarding of data. A DTA is for the transfer of de-identified data only.
- **Receiving Data Use Agreement (DUA).** A DUA establishes who is permitted to use and receive a Limited Data Set (LDS), and the permitted uses and disclosures of such information by the recipient. An LDS is described as health information that excludes certain direct identifiers, but that may include city; state; ZIP Code; elements of date; and other numbers, characteristics, or codes not listed as direct identifiers.
- **Providing and Receiving Material Transfer Agreement's (MTA) for human materials.** An MTA is a contract with terms that govern the transfer of tangible research materials between two or more organizations (universities, non-profit entities, or for-profit entities). The MTA defines the rights of the provider and the recipient with respect to the materials.
