

Postdoctoral Fellowship in Metastatic Dormancy and Recurrence

Postdoctoral positions are available in the laboratory of <u>Dr. Srinivas Malladi, Ph.D.</u>, Department of Pathology at UT Southwestern Medical Center to study metastatic dormancy and recurrences in breast, lung and renal Adenocarcinomas. <u>Malladi lab</u> is focused on developing improved diagnostic and therapeutic modalities for treating residual disease and metastasis. We employ molecular, biochemical, immunologic, genomic, imaging and computational based techniques to understand the biology of latent metastasis in cancers using mouse models, xenografts and patient samples.
