

## Postdoctoral Research Fellow – Mastorakos Research Lab

A postdoctoral training position is available in the laboratory of Dr. Panagiotis Mastorakos (<u>Faculty Profile</u>, <u>Lab Website</u>) in the Department of Neurological Surgery and Peter O'Donnell Jr. Brain Institute at UT Southwestern Medical Center. Our lab explores the role of the innate immune system in damage and repair following ischemic and hemorrhagic insults to the brain. We focus on neurosurgical diseases including aneurysmal subarachnoid hemorrhage, ischemic and hemorrhagic stroke, and subdural hemorrhage.

Candidates must hold a recent Ph.D. and/or M.D. degree. Experience in immunohistochemistry, tissue culture, flow cytometry, animal surgery and intravital microscopy and sequencing is valued. The post-doctoral fellow will be expected to lead projects, design experiments, and generate data that will lead to publication.
