

MENOPAUSAL & DEPRESSED?

The UT Southwestern PsychoNeuroEndocrine Research Group is currently recruiting volunteers for a clinical research study.

The primary goal of the study is to determine if the drug pregnenolone is associated with greater reduction in depressive symptom severity than placebo in women with current menopausal Major Depressive Disorder.

You may qualify to participate if you meet the following criteria:

- Peri- or post-menopausal woman age 40-67
- Experienced changes in menstrual cycle in past five years
- Currently experiencing significant menopause-related symptoms like hot flashes
- Feeling down or depressed

Benefits for study participants:

- Study medication
- Monitoring of your menopausal symptoms at no cost
- Compensation up to \$520 for completing the 16-week study
