

Participants needed for study on the effects of hormonal changes on the neuromuscular function of the limbs

The Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation Division at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas is conducting research to understand whether hormonal changes contribute to increased knee injuries in women.

Participants will undergo non-invasive brain and muscle stimulation. An MRI of the brain may also be provided at no cost to qualifying participating subjects. The time required for participation in this study is up to 3 months. There will be compensation for each subject who participates in the study. We are looking for healthy male and female participants between the ages of 18-39 years old. We are seeking female individuals who have regular menstrual periods and have not been pregnant in the past.
